

THE REHEARSAL SCHEDULE

- Rehearsals will be Monday through Friday from 2:45-5:30 EVERY WEEK UNTIL THE OPENING OF THE SHOW, beginning Monday January 13th. The size of your role and your conflicts will determine how often you will be called for rehearsals.
- MANDATORY REHEARSALS, WITH <u>NO EXCUSED ABSENCES</u> ALLOWED, ARE THE FOLLOWING:

*TECH REHEARSAL--April 5th 2:30pm-9:00pm

*DRESS REHEARSALS—April 7, 8, 9, and 10 --2:30-8:00pm

*PERFORMANCES—April 11, 12, 18, and 19




The Audition Process


- 1. Sign up in the Performing Arts Center. Sign up for a vocal audition time. (Note that your dance audition will be at 4:00pm on the day of your vocal audition.)
- 2. You must sing alone for the open audition.
- 3. You will enter the auditorium for auditions in groups of 5, but will sing alone. You must sing one of the selections included with this packet. You MUST sing with the piano.
- 4. For your dance audition you should wear comfortable-easy to move in- clothing (no jeans please). You should wear soft-soled shoes.
- 5. If you are invited to the callback audition on Friday, be ready to sing the music that is included with this packet. There may be new music to sing as well.
- 6. Fill out the enclosed audition application form completely *prior* to your audition. Be sure to look over the general rehearsal schedule.
- 7. <u>List any conflicts on your audition application form.</u> Only emergency conflicts will be honored after the show is cast.
- 8. Arrive at the audition at least 10 minutes ahead of your audition time. This will give you some time to relax, and if the auditions are running ahead of schedule, we can move along. If you are late for your audition, we may not be able to see you.
- 9. Check in with the stage manager <u>outside the lower auditorium doors</u>. Give your completed application form to the stage manager.
- 10. When you are called for your audition, take a deep breath, relax, and give it your best!
 - There is a \$150.00 cast fee if you are cast in this production. The fee covers the cost of your show shirt, and other various expenses. If money is an issue, please do not let that discourage you from auditioning.
 - Cast members may have to purchase character or jazz shoes. Cost is between \$35-40.
 - Talk to me privately if you are cast and money is an issue.
